

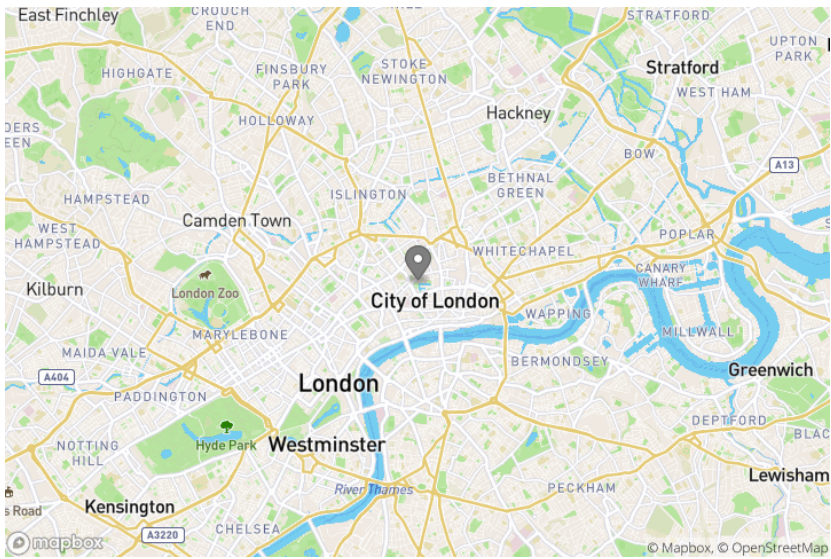
Frozen moment of the 70s
