

Lud's Church - Edges



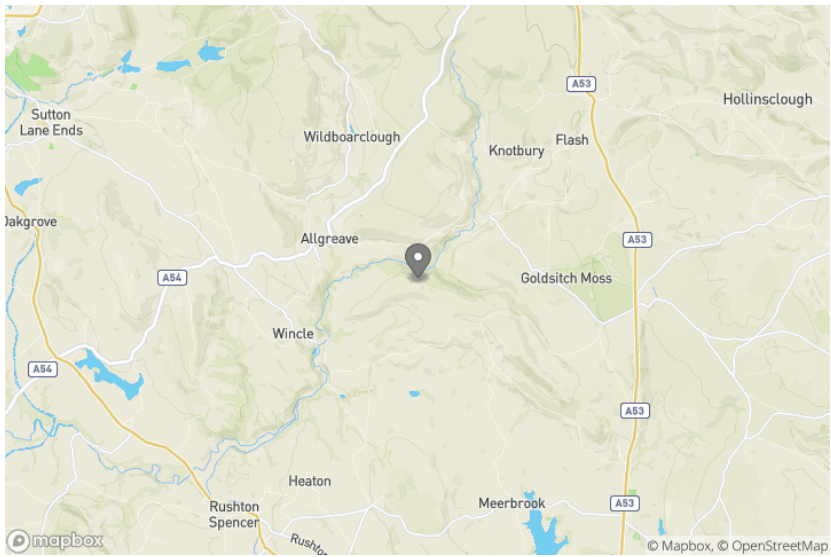
