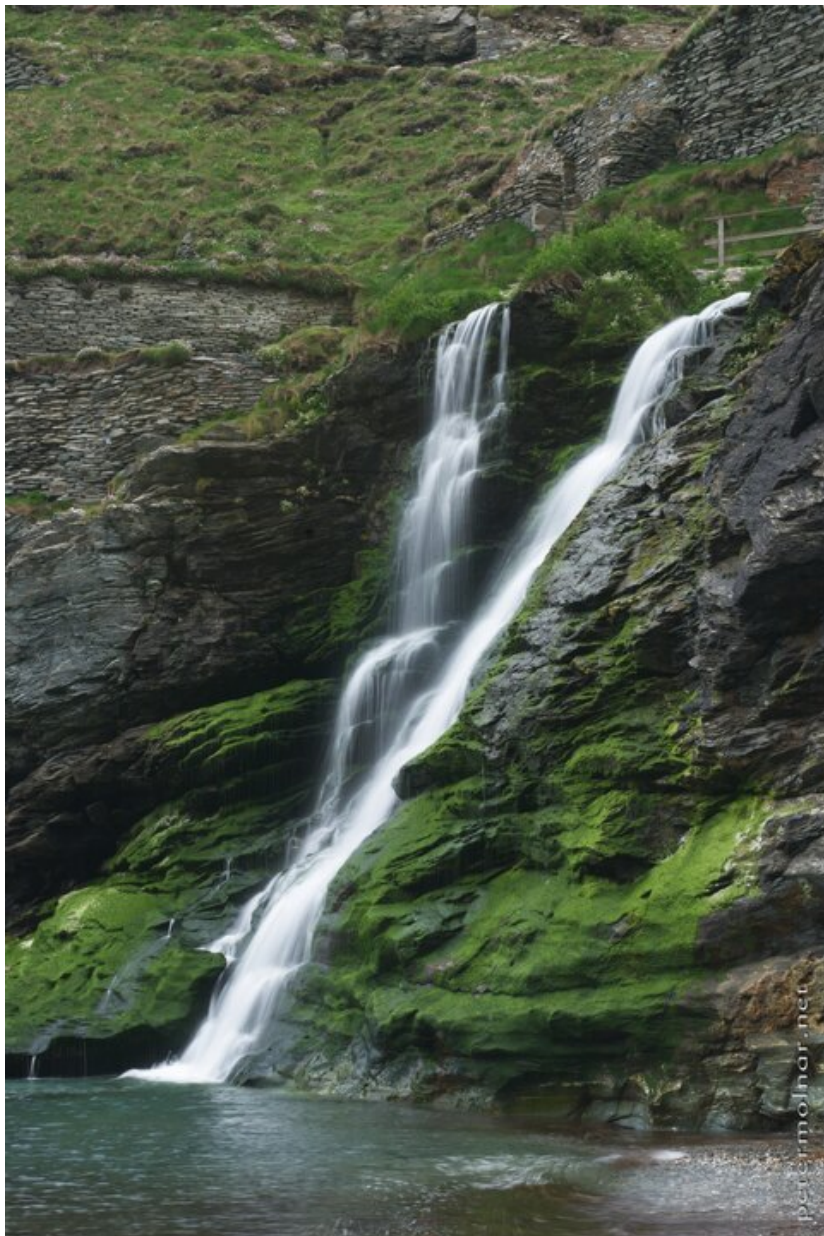


# South-West England - Waterfall of Tintagel



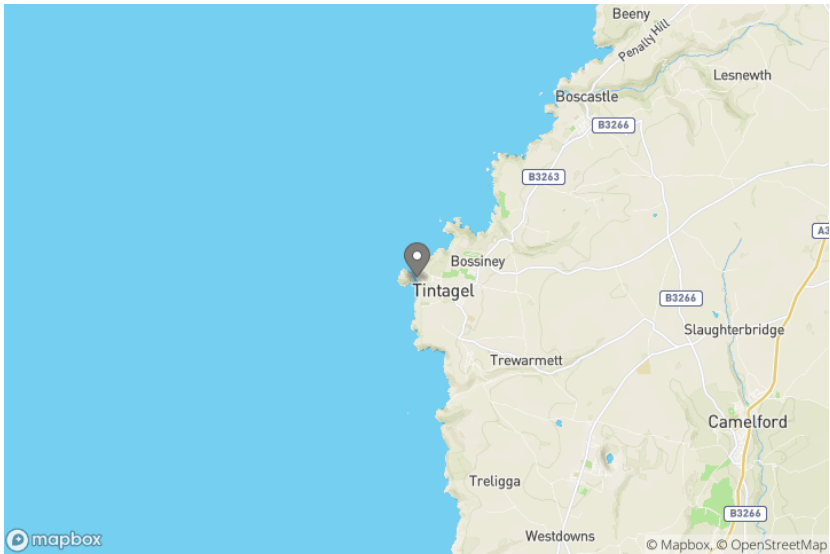
