The locals use the field next to it for picnic, among a serious amount of asbestos warning signs - by looking in the windows there's cracked AIB ceiling everywhere, so I got as far as I could fast.

The internet then showed me how this place looked only 11 years ago^[1] and it's hard to believe how much destruction 11 years of weather - and looting - can do to a place.
